

Directions to Portland VA Medical Center By Bus:

• TriMet bus #8 runs about every 20 minutes from Downtown to the VA Hospital. Go to www.trimet.org to find arrival times or to plan your route with the Trip Planner.

**PLEASE NOTE: TriMet is currently requiring riders to wear masks. There are mask dispensers on the bus if you don't have your own. TriMet is now accepting cash payments on buses again. Please go to https://trimet.org/health/index.htm for information on other ways to pay.

Finding NCRAR (from riding the bus):

• Get off the bus at the Veteran's Hospital main entrance (the second stop on US Veterans Hospital Road). DO NOT GO INTO THE MAIN HOSPITAL LOBBY, instead walk across the street to the building opposite (BLDG 103 on map).





• When you cross the street, you will walk around the flower beds in the center.

• Turn right and walk down the sidewalk that runs alongside the building, toward the Primary Care Clinic entrance. You will enter through automatic glass doors at the end of the sidewalk.





• Walk past the Primary Care Clinic to the elevators ahead. Take the elevator to P5 (bottom floor).





• You will take a left out of the elevator and see two big glass doors. This is the National Center for Rehabilitative Auditory Research (NCRAR).



 Before entering the lobby, please sanitize your hands, and make sure you are wearing a face mask. If you brought your own mask, we may ask you to change to a mask we provide. Please wait in the lobby for someone to assist you.
