HEARING RESEARCH STUDY

We are recruiting participants for a research study on hearing problems in blast-exposed Veterans who have normal hearing test results (study title: Blast Exposed Veterans with Auditory Complaints)

Veterans 20 to 50 years of age may be eligible for this study if they meet the following criteria:

- **Have normal or near normal hearing**
- **Have difficulty hearing in noisy situations (but normal hearing tests) with at least one of the following:**
 - **History of blast exposure**
 - **History of mild traumatic brain injury (mTBI) due to blast exposure**
 - **History of PTSD**

OR

- **Have normal hearing**
- **Have no history of blast exposure, brain injury or PTSD**

The study consists of up to 9 study visits over a period of about 2 months.

Qualified subjects will receive \$25 for travel and \$50 for each test session.
