


Volunteers Needed for Research Study



The National Center for Rehabilitative Auditory Research (NCRAR), located at the Portland VAMC, needs **VOLUNTEERS** for a **RESEARCH STUDY** to determine whether listening training can help people who wear hearing aids



- We need volunteers with hearing aids who are between the ages of 55-85 years.
- Participants will have an ear exam, and have tests of memory, hearing, and manual dexterity. Some of those in the study will have computerized training at home 30 minutes a day, five days a week for 4 weeks.
- Qualified subjects will receive \$25 for each of the 4 visits at the NCRAR.

An appointment will be arranged for the first visit to see whether you meet the study criteria. The study will require a total of 4 visits of about 2 hours each at the NCRAR over an 8 month period. This is a research study and should not be considered to be treatment.
